- Who is Siddhartha Gautama and what is a Buddha?

- What diverse expressions of Buddhism can be found around the world?

- Buddhist practices: **stupas**, **viharas**, prayer, **sutras**, meditation and mindfulness
- Monastic life in Buddhism
- Diversity in Buddhism: Theravada Buddhism and Mahayana Buddhism
