The questions we might ask:

- ➤ How do Muslim beliefs connect with the Muslim understanding of Allah?
- What sources of authority do Muslims use to inform their beliefs about Allah?
- In what diverse ways do Muslims demonstrate their beliefs about Allah?

The ideas we might explore

- Oneness of God (tawhid)
- Key characteristics of God 99 Names of Allah
- Six articles of faith (iman):
 - o Belief in Allah as the one and only God
 - o Belief in angels
 - o Belief in the holy books
 - o Belief in the Prophets
 - o Belief in the Day of Judgement
 - o Belief in God's predestination
- Sources of authority for Muslim beliefs about God: Qur'an, Hadith, Sunnah
- Diverse expressions of belief in Islam: Sunni, Shia, Sufi (Tasawwuf)
- Creative expression of belief, e.g. Islamic art and architecture
