Lincolnshire Locally Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education KS3 Compulsory Unit: Community (Christianity)



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The questions we might ask:

- > What kinds of Christian experiences are there?
- > What range of Christian denominations are there in the UK and what are the similarities/differences in their expression of faith?
- > How does a person become a Christian?

The ideas we might explore

- Different denominations of Christianity: Roman Catholic, Orthodox, Protest, e.g. Anglican, Methodist, Quaker, Evangelical
- Religious communities, e.g. Benedictines, Franciscans, Community of St Anselm
- Diverse forms of Christian worship, e.g. silence, meditation, Taizé, Greenbelt, Spring Harvest, bible study, etc.
- Diverse forms of Christian action, e.g. social action
- Becoming a Christian conversion, being 'born into' Christianity, etc.
