The questions we might ask:

- What core Muslim beliefs/teachings influence Muslim action in the world?
- How and why do Muslims engage in social action?
- Why do Muslims understand struggle/effort (jihad) to be a key feature of their faith?

The ideas we might explore

- Belief in Allah (God) and beliefs about the origins and purpose of human beings
- The concept of **tawhid** and the way this relates to the concept of **submission**
- The straight path (shariah) and its implications for Muslim ethical action
- Observation of the Five Pillars of Sunni Islam or the Ten Obligatory Acts of Shia Islam
- Social action in Islam, e.g. Muslim Hands UK, Islamic Relief, Human Appeal, etc.
- Greater and lesser jihad
