## The questions we might ask:

- What do Hindus believe about Brahman?
- What is the significance of murtis?
- What do Hindus believe about the relationship between individual deities and Brahman?
- In what way is the Hindu belief about the cyclical nature of the universe reflected by belief in the Trimurti?

## The ideas we might explore

- Beliefs about **Brahman** (**Bhagwan**), the Ultimate Reality: supreme truth, unchanging principle, cause of existence, connections with the cycle of life
- The atman and its connection with **Brahman** (**Bhagwan**)
- Deities, e.g. the **Trimurti**, and their connection with **Brahman** (**Bhagwan**)
- Avatars representations of the deities in human from, e.g. Krishna
- Murtis representations of the deities; connection between murtis and Brahman (Bhagwan)
- The cycle of life and its connection with Brahman (Bhagwan) and the Trimurti
