

## From Jackie Waters-Dewhurst, Diocesan Director of Education

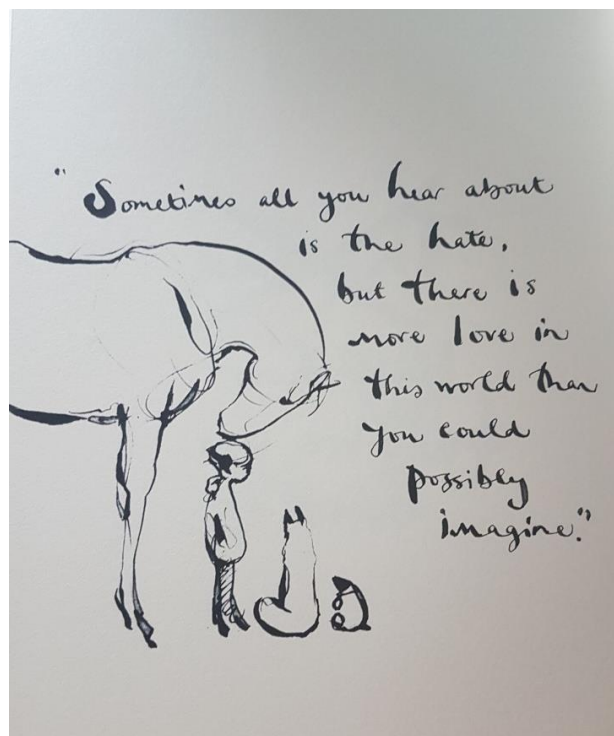
Dear All –
