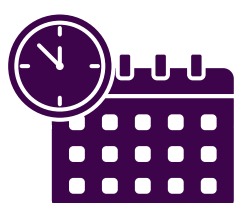
**David Gibbons and Sarah Hollamby - Nettleham Church of England Junior School
